“Washoe County is currently updating the Master Plan for the entire unincorporated area. This update is occurring at the same time that important community issues are being discussed that impact the Warm Springs Area Plan, and Warm Springs Specific Area Plan, which is a component of the overall county master plan. For this reason, the project managers for the update would like to hear from interested community members regarding their concerns and ideas for the future. County Senior Planner Eric Young will be in the community on February 2nd to learn more about the area. He will be accompanied by professional planning consultants Megan Moore and Melissa Ruth from the firm Logan-Simpson. After they have completed a tour of the Warm Springs planning area, they will be stopping at the regional shooting facility to meet with anyone who can come by. They will be there from 4:30 to 5:30. They can explain what the update is intended to accomplish, but they would like to spend most of their time asking us questions and hearing from us about the future of our community.
